Camper Dress Code

Our goal is to create a safe, comfortable, and respectful environment for everyone. Please follow these guidelines. Campers who are not in dress code will be kindly asked to change into appropriate clothing.

General Guidelines

- Clothing should not be revealing or excessively tight
- Clothing may not display offensive language, inappropriate graphics, or profanity
- Pants and shorts should be worn at the waist (no sagging)
- No text or wording on the back of shorts or pants

Length & Fit

- Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be at least fingertip length
- Tank tops must have straps that are at least 4 finger widths wide
- No crop tops or shirts where midriff is showing

Coverage

- Clothing must fully cover the stomach, chest, and back
- No visible bras or undergarments

Swimwear

- Girls: One-piece swimsuit
 - JR High Camp must wear athletic or swim shorts over swimsuit
- Guys: Must wear proper swim trunks (athletic shorts are not considered swimwear)
- Shirts must be worn at all times, except when swimming
- All campers must wear clothing to and from the pool

Footwear

- Closed-toe shoes are required for activities
- Sandals must have a back strap
