S H I R T S

- Loose-fitting.
- Modest neckline (avoid low v-neck and low scoop neck shirts that sag when bending over).
- Shirts need to be long enough to avoid showing the midriff. (No Cropped shirts, Baby tees, or fitted / tight shirts.
- You may want to bring a light jacket, cardigan, sweater, sweatshirt, or long sleeve shirt
- Tank tops must have at least a four-finger width strap and must not show any undergarments
- Shorts must be visible at all times. No Lampshading. If the shirt is longer than the shorts, you will be asked to either tuck in your shirt or go change!

S H O E S

- Athletic shoes or boots.
- Sandals (Chacos, Crocs etc.) are ok! Make sure they have a back strap.
- No flip-flops (except at the pool).

S U N D A Y S

- Skirts or dresses must come right above the knee or longer (leggings can be worn under skirts or dresses).
- If there is a slit, the highest point must at the knee (or the slit can be sewn together to fingertip length).
- When shirts are worn over skirts, they must be long enough to cover the entire midriff, even when arms are raised or when bending over at the waist or tucked in.
- Shirts and dresses must have a modest neckline.
- No spaghetti straps, sleeveless dresses, or shirts unless they meet the 4-finger-width rule.
- Jeans with no holes are ok at more casual dress churches.

S H O R T S / P A N T S

- Wear a belt with your khaki shorts and issued Marannook shirt for uniform days.
- Shorts must come to mid-thigh or fingertips standing or sitting.
- No holes, cut-offs, or frayed hems
- Loose-fitting pants and shorts.
- Overalls, athletic pants, jeans, and skorts are ok.
- Avoid short, tight athletic-type shorts or pants (no leggings or yoga pants unless under a dress or fingertip-length skirt).
- No compression or biker shorts.

S W I M S U I T

- One-piece swimsuit.
- Wear athletic shorts or a skirt that completely covers your bottom at all times. (not spandex/ compression/ biker)
- The back of your swimsuit must come above your natural waistline.
- Swim rompers and dresses are OK if they are full coverage.
- Neckline should be high enough so that no cleavage shows (especially when bending over); no V-necks.
- Must have appropriate cupping.
 - Sports bras may be worn underneath if needed.

P I E R C I N G S / T A T T O O S / H A I R

- No nose studs or hoops. Clear inserts are ok.
- Any visible tattoos must be completely covered during the entirety of the camper sessions.
- Hair should be a natural-looking color. If you're unsure whether a color fits within these guidelines, please check with Sid in advance.

S H I R T S

- Shirts with sleeves.
- Loose-fitting.
- Shirts must be worn at all times except when swimming.
- Consider bringing a light jacket, sweatshirt, or a long-sleeve button-down shirt.

S H O E S

- Athletic shoes or boots.
- Sandals (Chacos, Crocs etc.) are ok! Make sure they have a back strap.
- No flip-flops (except at the pool).

S U N D A Y S

- Dress pants must meet the standards under "Short/Pants."
- Church slacks (not Jeans)
- Bring a dress shirt and a "polo" style shirt.
- Appropriate shoes and socks.

H A I R

- Hair level in front must be at the eyebrows or above. Hair level in the back must be above the collar unless further discussed in the interview.
- Must be clean-shaven or have a well-maintained beard.
- Hair should be a natural-looking color.

S H O R T S / P A N T S

- Wear a belt with your khaki shorts and issued Marannook shirt for uniform days.
- Shorts must come to mid-thigh or below fingertips, whichever is longer.
- No holes, cut-offs, or frayed hems.
- No mesh gym shorts.
- Nothing too tight.
- No sagging.
- You will need khaki shorts for uniform day church slacks (not jeans) and work pants

S W I M S U I T

- Wear swimsuits of the boxer variety.
- Wear at normal hip level.
- No speedos.

P I E R C I N G S / T A T T O O S

- No piercings
- Any visible tattoos must be completely covered during the entirety of each camper session.
